The climate change has now become unequivocal topic for every one globally. This has been proved by many scientific evidences and the occurrence of number natural calamities which has occurred during three decades. This change is also a combination of a number of other factors, such as increasing concentrations of GHG such as Co₂, methane, nitrous oxide. All this is due to the burning of the fossil fuel which is about 96 million barrels per day globally.
