

The Bacha Khan University Charsadda administration has staged a protest rally against the desecration of the Holy Quran in Norwegian city of Kristiansand, the protest rally was held at the premises of the university and led by the Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr S.M. Saqlan Naqvi. Registrar Syed Arif Hussain, Director P&D Dr. Akbar Shah Mohmand, Director Admin Dr. Salim Shah, Provost Hayat Khan, Department Heads, Teachers and hundreds of students also took part in the protest rally.

While addressing the protesters, the vice chancellor strongly condemned the heinous act of burning the Holy Quran and demanded of the Norwegian government to stop playing with the sentiments of Muslims.

He added that every Muslim would not bear such acts in future and would be ready for any sort of sacrifice in this regard. He said that such actions hurt the sentiments of 1.3 billion Muslims around the world, including those in Pakistan. Furthermore, such actions could not be justified in the name of freedom of expression

The vice chancellor also urged Norwegian authorities to bring those responsible to justice and to prevent the recurrence of any such incident in the future.

He directed the registrar to write a protest note to the Embassy of Norway at Islamabad and express the concerns and protest to the Norwegian Authorities.

Dr Saqlan urged the students to focus on their studies and make the getting of knowledge stronger that the people could not be able to do such mistakes again and again.
